Principal's Corner

Congratulations to Sarah Lynch and Camden Vitagliano, winners of the West Side Run T-shirt Contest. Their artwork was so spectacular that the West Side Run committee is working to merge their ideas together for this year's t-shirt. On Monday, 2nd, 3rd and 4th grade students were mesmerized by the Lincoln Center Institute's production of *Boats. Boats* is a rich work of art that ties in storytelling, poetry, imaginative learning, music, puppetry, dance, and use of imagination. In *Boats* puppets and sound effects are created on the spot, using objects one might find in a ship's galley—a theatrical concept that, along with original sea shanties, enhanced the story's poetic narrative. *Boats* was written by Finegan Kruckemeyer, acclaimed playwright for young audiences, whose work has been staged internationally and won numerous awards. It was performed by the Terrapin Puppet Theatre from Australia and directed by Frank Newman. On Tuesday, West Side Kids Care worked with our students during recess to support the Cole Foundation. Thank you to Robert Shammah who kicked this off Tuesday morning and to Mrs. Lynch for organizing. I cannot think of a more wonderful way for our students to spend their time. To celebrate West Side Wednesday, fifth graders, Allie Lynch, Serena Li, Kaitlyn Fare, Dayna Emanuel, and Abigail Johnson performed "Sunshine Soca" on steel drums during morning assembly. Great job, girls! Also on Wednesday, our sixth graders took a field trip to the Cloisters and St. John the Divine where they enjoyed making the connection of what they learned in the classroom and saw in the museum. New York State Testing

When we return from break, students in grades **three** through **six** will be taking the NYS ELA and Math Assessments. The NYS ELA test will be administered on April 16-18 and the NYS Math test will be administered on April 24-26. Parents can help to prepare their children for success by:

- ensuring children get a good night's sleep before each day of testing
- providing children with a balanced breakfast on the morning of the exam
- encouraging children to try their hardest
- making sure children arrive to school on time

West Side Kids Care

Our students had another opportunity to make a difference in the world this week. In the United States, about 46 children and adolescents are diagnosed with cancer every single school day. Through "Kids Unite to Fight", West Side students were matched up with some of those children who suffer from this serious illness. Our goal was to bring smiles to these children who did not have a choice when it came to cancer. Because of their disease, many of these kids cannot attend school, spend time with friends their own age, or live what we would consider a normal life. We had such a wonderful response from our students, that we actually ran out of matches before all of the recess periods were over! West Side students wrote 75 wonderful letters of introduction, friendship, and encouragement to these children. The Community Room was full of wonderful attitudes and open hearts as our children tailored their notes to the age of his/her sick child, drew cheerful pictures, and marked the US map for both NY and the state of the recipient. All children who participated were given a brochure from the "Kids Unite to Fight" program that included specific information about the child he/she helped. This information included a webpage that would enable you to learn the story of his/her child, follow the progress of his/her new friend, and potentially continue an ongoing connection through web postings, letters and emails. A big thank you to Robert Shammah who introduced this new program at morning assembly and to Dana Leopold, Lorena Munyak, Vicky Roberts, Ana Shammah, Annette Haas, Susan Kopp, and Diane Angelides for helping the children with their letters. A tremendous thank you to our children (there were too many to list individually!) who participated whole heartedly and brightened the day of children less fortunate than themselves. They amaze me more each time we do a program like this!




