

Don't throw out those smelly, old sneakers...recycle them!

Since it was so popular in its debut last year, West Side families will again have the opportunity to participate in Nike's Reuse-A-Shoe program as a part of Earth Month. The program collects worn-out athletic shoes for recycling. Nearly every part of the shoe will be transformed into Nike Grind, a material used in creating athletic and playground surfaces as well as select Nike products.

Any brand of athletic shoes is accepted. No sandals, flip-flops, dress shoes, boots, or shoes containing metal such as cleats or spikes please.




The following list shows what part of the shoe and approximately how many pairs of athletic shoes, or the manufacturing equivalent thereof, generally go into making each type of athletic surface:

- Outdoor basketball court (midsole foam): 2,500 pairs
- Outdoor tennis court (midsole foam): 2,500 pairs
- Full field or soccer pitch (outsole rubber): 50,000 75.000 pairs
- Mini soccer field (outsole rubber): 10,000 20,000 pairs
- Running track (outsole rubber): 75,000 pairs
- Playground (outsole rubber): 2,500 pairs
- Indoor wood basketball court (upper fabric): 2,500 pairs
- Indoor synthetic basketball court (midsole foam): 2,500 pairs

# "Flight of Higher Learning"

# On Exhibit at the Cold Spring Harbor Library and Environmental Center



When you walk into the Cold Spring Harbor Library and head up the stairs, you will notice our new art installation, "Flight of Higher Learning," by local artist Tonito Valderrama.

A recurring theme in Tonito's work is the relationships expressed between humankind and nature. He uses sticks, stones, wood, clay and paint. "Flight of Higher Learning" features four birds in flight (two in the stairwell and two in the Hands On Learning Center), constructed of recycled bamboo blinds and rice paper.

Please come visit the Library and see these amazing pieces April 1 through August 31, 2013. His work has previously been displayed at the Tilles Center, Heckscher Museum of Art, Main St. Petite Gallery, Briarcliffe College, Suffolk Community College, Humes Japanese Stroll Garden, the South Carolina Legislature Building, Art Sites Gallery and in many private collections.
