

## Principal's Corner

This week in Grade 2, students learned problem solving with doubles in Math, worked with short and long "o" sounds in Spelling, and collaborated with their book buddies during Reading. In Grade 3, students made flashcards in Social Studies, played a game to learn more about fact and opinion, and discussed various mystery series. In Grade 4, students participated in a circuits and magnetism lab during Science, brainstormed different ways to "show" instead of "tell" in the area of Writing, and discussed the work of authors they are familiar with, which will help them as they write their personal narratives. In Grade 5, students worked with a representative from the DNA Learning Center and participated in a Science lab in which they built their own cell models. Fifth graders also worked on increasing their stamina in the area of Reading, reviewed place value in Math, and studied regions of the United States. In Physical Education, students played speedball. Finally in Grade 6, students learned about identity properties in Math, studied conversion of measurements in Science, participated in an in-depth discussion about the Great Pyramids of Giza, and talked about what elements make a civilization a rich one in Social Studies.
