West Side School Nominated for Prestigious National Blue Ribbon Award

We are proud to be nominated as a Blue Ribbon School in the category of "Exemplary High Performing Schools" based on last year's NYS ELA and Math test scores. According to the New York State Department of Education website, as of fall 2009, there were 4,529 public schools in the State of New York. This year only 19 out of the approximately 4,500 schools across the State were nominated as Blue Ribbon schools. This includes elementary schools, middle schools and high schools. Thank you to our teachers for your endless dedication, to our students for your hard work, and to our parents who continue to support us in educating your children. This truly is an honor.

This week our second graders listened to a presentation on the Teach Children to Save program from Colleen Destefano of the First National Bank of Long Island. They also learned to add multiples of ten using a hundreds chart. Our third graders spent time estimating and learning about different types of physical features in Social Studies. They also spent time with Ms. Latham learning how to take a metamoment. Fourth graders compared and contrasted the elements of personal essay and personal narrative and shared some wonderful ideas with classmates about what their newest writing pieces could be about. Our fifth graders took a field trip to Stony Brook in order to visit the Carriage Museum where they participated in the Wagons West program. Students had the opportunity to pack a covered wagon just like the pioneers did in the 1800s when they prepared for their long trek west. In sixth grade, students worked on songs about literary devices which they plan to present to the school, participated in hands-on equations in Math, and discovered how to classify living things during Science.
