TRIP SPECIFICS

- Children should leave book bags at home.
- ALL school rules are in effect and electronic devices, such as video games, ipods, cell
 phones and cameras, may not be used during the trip (as well as on the bus). If any such
 device is seen, it will be taken away by the chaperone.
- Students will report to the café at 11:00 for lunch and will board the buses from there. Please sit at your assigned lunch tables.
- Lunch will be available to purchase (through the cafeteria) or, if you bring lunch from home, please use disposable items, since we will not be returning into the building once we get back from the trip.
- You may not bring your own snacks for the bus. Only school-provided food may be eaten during "snack time" (Ms. Tiger has prepared snacks for us).
- It is **not necessary** for the children **to bring any money** with them for shopping or food.

PICK UP

- *We hope to return to school at approximately 7:30 pm*. If the time deviates more than a half hour (either way), a "connect ed" message (automated call) will be sent to your primary phone number.
- Parents should pick up their children by the Little Theater entrance. Please park your car and walk to the door to meet your child.
- Please do not park in the bus circle, The buses will be using this area to drop off the children.

Students should remember that this is a Broadway performance and dress and act accordingly. Shorts are not permitted and sports jerseys and athletic attire are strongly discouraged. Also, the students have been reminded that our <u>best LHS behavior is expected at all times</u>.
