

Happy Earth Day Birthday! Today West Side celebrated its 226th birthday. We honored our history at morning assembly with former Principal, Ted Hilton, who shared "The George Washington Story." It is hard to believe that America's first President helped the men of Cold Spring Harbor lift one of the rafters of our original school house which in 1790 was known as Bungtown School. Mr. Hilton also shared the research behind the story and the documentation of President Washington's journey through Long Island centuries ago. This has become an annual tradition for our older students, and today our second graders heard it for the first time. Mr. Hilton also joined Dr. Dawkins' class and regaled them with stories of years past including tales of Eva Risley Clark. Students had the opportunity to ask a number of questions, and we are grateful that the former Principal shared his time with our students.

Directions to West Side Run


The West Side School is located just one block north of Route 25A in the village of Laurel Hollow, Syosset, NY.

From the West

Take the LIE or Northern State to Route 106. Turn left- North, to Route 25A, Northern Blvd. Turn right- East, on 25A. Continue for 3.2 miles, just past the 4th traffic light, turn left onto Laurel Hollow Road (don't go down the hill on 25A). Follow the signs to the parking area.

From the East


On 25A continue through Huntington and Cold Spring Harbor past the Fish Hatchery, on left, and the Cold Spring Lab, on right, up to the top of the hill on 25A. Turn right on Laurel Hollow Road at the hilltop, *before* the traffic light. Follow the signs to the parking area.

At the conclusion of the evening, several of our 8th grade students will conduct tours of the building for those parents who may be new to our school.


