Click on the **Information for Parents** link on the left side of the page. Please consider this list a guide to helping your child select books that would be comfortable for him/her to read this summer. There are also many good suggestions in your child's Summer Reading packet, thanks to Mrs. Fraiberg. **Reading aloud to children** helps them build critical thinking, comprehension skills, vocabulary, and most importantly, a positive attitude about reading. For ideas, please see the Parent Summer Reading Powerpoint, also in the Information for Parents section of our website. Your child also has access to Raz-Kids, an online reading program.



**Remember, just 15 minutes of reading a day can make a big difference in your child's life!**

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**SUMMER READING**

**First graders** received information about summer reading from their next schools.

**Kindergarten students** learned about **Flipgrid** today. Flipgrid is an app that will enable students to view short videos of their peers giving reviews of books they've read and enjoyed. Then they can record themselves sharing their own book for others to view. We hope this helps to encourage students to read more and share their love of books with each other this summer. An instruction packet was sent home with your child today and the link will be posted on the Goosehill website. All you need is a device on which you can download the free app and record your child. (e.g. phone, iPad, laptop) If you do not have the proper equipment, simply email Mrs. Herschlein over the summer and she will arrange for you to do the recording at school. (First graders are invited to view the videos too!)

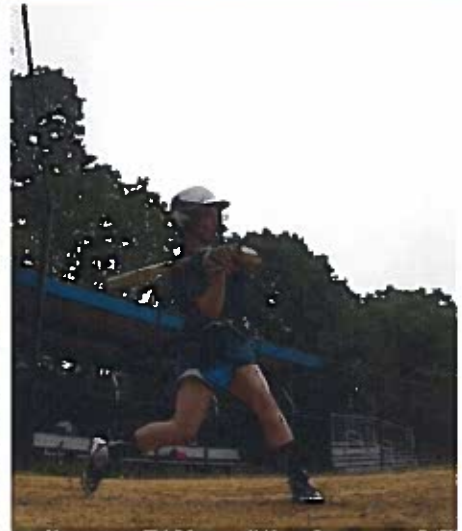

Science Enhancement Opportunities

## Summer Science Programs

### **NASA - SPACE EXPLORERS (NASA)**

Learn about the four forces of flight, the challenges of space travel, and participate in a rocket launch in this hands-on space exploration camp. (Children entering grades 3-6)

### **FLIGHT ACADEMY (FA)**

Explore the aerodynamics of birds, kites and rockets! Build flying machines as you explore Newton's laws of motion. (Children entering grades 1-4)

### **FORENSIC SCIENCE (FS)**

Focus on the science of forensics in this hands-on look at crime scenes! Collect evidence, recreate a crime scene, and identify suspects as you learn the science of sleuthing. (Children entering grades 2-6)

### **CRAZY CHEMWORKS (CCW)**

Get your goggles ready to handle real lab equipment and experiment with chemical changes. Explore the microscopic world of molecules as we discover states of matter! (Children entering grades 2-6)

### **BRIXOLOGY (BRIX)**

Using LEGO® bricks children will build different engineering-themed projects every day. They will explore the mechanical, structural, aerospace, nautical, and bioengineering fields, and participate in collaborative engineering challenges to solve real world problems. Each day they will take home an educational toy to reinforce each concept. (Children entering grades 2-6)

### **JUNIOR ROBOTICS (JR)**

This introduction to robotics explores basic circuitry, mechanical science, and robot building. Each camper works daily on a robot to bring home at the end of the week! (Children entering grades K-3)

### **ROBOT ENGINEERS (RE)**

Discover the science of robots! Learn how different robots work and use their components to explore what is around them. Use your engineering skills to build a working robot to take home! (Children entering grades 3-6)

### **ROBOTS & REACTIONS (R&R)**

Work with robots and create chemical reactions as we uncover the nuts and bolts of the universe. Each camper builds a working robot to take home! (Children entering grades 2-5)

### **ADVANCED ROBOTICS (AR)**

Learn about how different robots operate. Put your robotic knowledge to the test! Use your skills to build your very own Robotic Arm to take home! (Children entering grades 3-6)
