Kindergarten students learned about Flipgrid today. Flipgrid is an app that will enable students to view short videos of their peers giving reviews of books they've read and enjoyed. Then they can record themselves sharing their own book for others to view. We hope this helps to encourage students to read more and share their love of books with each other this summer. An instruction packet was sent home with your child today and the link will be posted on the Goosehill website. All you need is a device on which you can download the free app and record your



child. (e.g. phone, iPad, laptop) If you do not have the proper equipment, simply email Mrs. Herschlein over the summer and she will arrange for you to do the recording at school. (First graders are invited to view the videos too!)
