We continued our plans for the Kindness Theme:

- We reflected on the Family Focus Kindness Choice Boards. Student work will be shared in classrooms and in morning announcements.
- We considered another option for families for February---a **Family Kindness Journal**, where children and parents can record acts of kindness over the course of a few weeks.
- We reviewed December activities: 1) Kindness ForceField---neon paper chain 2) Game Day (12/22)
- We reviewed plan for Backpacks for Buddies. First graders will pack backpacks 9-10:30 on 11-30. All members are invited to help set up and pack beginning at 8:15 a.m.
- We wrote a Kindness Pledge to be introduced to students at a Spirit Day in January:

I pledge to use nice words Each and every day. I promise to be kind In my work and in my play.

We considered adding a stanza to the first grade pledge once the first part is learned.

- We tentatively decided on a title for a Parent Book Club related to our theme. The title is: <u>The Me, Me, Me Epidemic: A Step by Step Guide to Raising Capable, Grateful Kids in an Over-Entitled World</u> by Amy McCready. Please read about the book and send in your thoughts. We will let parents know about the book in December and schedule our meetings in January.
- We began brainstorming ideas for the **Kindness Day** of Workshops—the tentative date is Wednesday, March 28th half day of school. We would invite parents and staff members to conduct workshops related to the theme of kindness. Ideas included: healthy eating (Be kind to your body), yoga or meditation (Be kind to your mind), gardening (Be kind to the Earth), Kind words (in another language?), A workshop on disabilities (be kind to others who may be different), Sportsmanship (Be a kind teammate), etc.
- We discussed a book drive to support Book Fairies, a Long-Island based charity that facilitates the collection and distribution of books to schools and children in the area. We may connect it to Earth Week Activities.
