

Science 7 Classroom Discipline Plan
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Dear Parent / Gaurdian,

I am delighted that _____ is in our class this year. We can all look forward to many exciting and rewarding experiences as the year progresses. CLASSROOM RULES:

1. **You must be in your seat when the bell rings.** Your notebook should be open and you should copy and complete the **DO NOW** when assigned.
2. You must have your notebook in class everyday.
3. Homework is due on the day you are instructed to complete the work. If it is not handed in on time you receive a zero. If you are absent, call a classmate or check the E-Board for assignments you missed. It is your responsibility to make-up the class work.
4. Remain seated and quite from the late bell to the dismissal bell. (Note: The dismissal bell is for me. I will dismiss you. No one should get out of his/her seat until told to do so.)
5. If you wish to ask or answer a question please **RAISE YOUR HAND.** I cannot hear or answer more than one question at a time.
6. You are responsible for all work missed due to absence. Please make sure all late work is handed to me directly. If you miss an exam due to a legal absence, you will be expected to take the exam the day you return to school.
7. There is **No** gum chewing, eating or drinking in class.
8. Extra help times will be announced in class and posted on the weekly assignment sheet.
9. No Cursing is allowed under any circumstances. Let's respect each other. If someone is talking, we will **ALL** listen attentively. No one likes to be ignored.
10. Junior high students are not permitted to wear hats in class.
