

He is currently an assistant coach at Nassau Community College. He is the NJCAA Wrestling Coach of the Year 2012.

Vougar's son, Nick Arujau, is a three-time state champion from New York (2008, 2009, 2010) and All-American. Nick is currently on the Cornell University wrestling team.

Mike Graffolla- Four Time High School State Champion from Virginia, High School National Champion and NJCAA National Champion.
