Dear Parents,

Our annual LHSPTG-sponsored **Fall Festival** event will be held on Friday, October 30. There will be games, dancing, mini-golf and more! We are hoping for good weather so the Festival can be held on the field. In the event of rain, we will be indoors.

STUDENTS ARE INVITED TO COME TO SCHOOL DRESSED IN COSTUMES. **Please leave at home all masks, props, dangerous accessories, and items that resemble weapons.** Faces should not be completely covered or painted (however accent make-up is ok). Check your child's bag to ensure that what is coming to school is appropriate and safe. All pieces of the costume should be labeled with your child's name. Children who don't want to wear costumes are invited to wear black and orange.

Each grade level is scheduled to visit our Fall Festival at a specific time. Parents are welcome to attend. We ask that visitors follow the same costume guidelines.

Please also remember, although we love them, dogs (and other pets) are not permitted at school events.

If you do choose to pick up your child after school, please understand that you will have to wait in the "pick-up" line. **Students will only be released prior to dismissal for emergency purposes.**

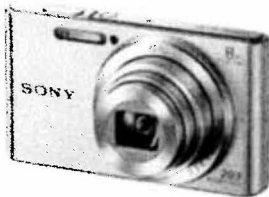
