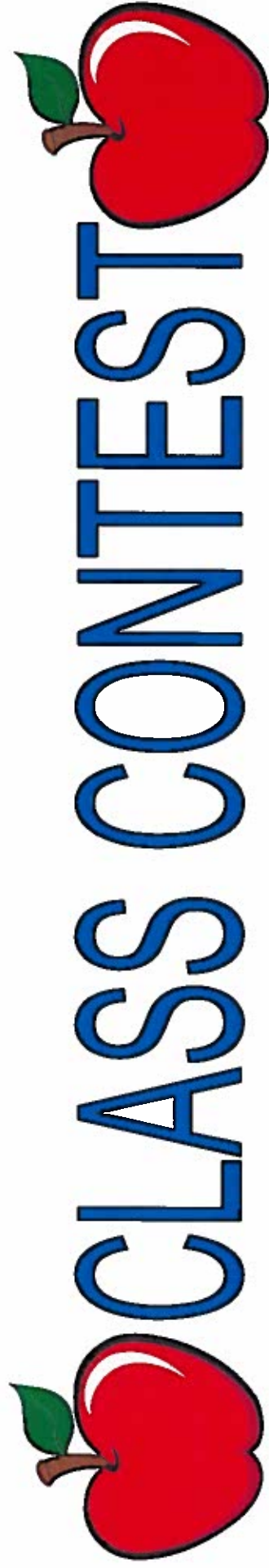
### **BOXTOPS**

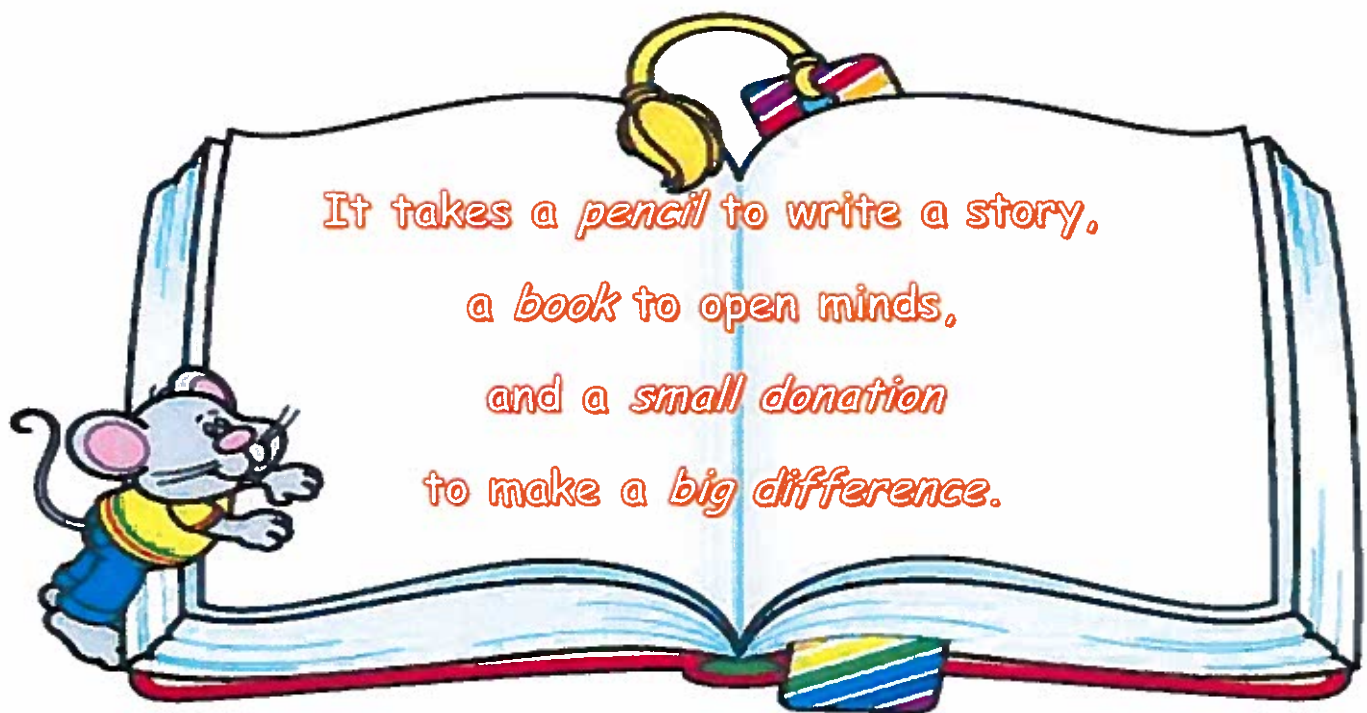

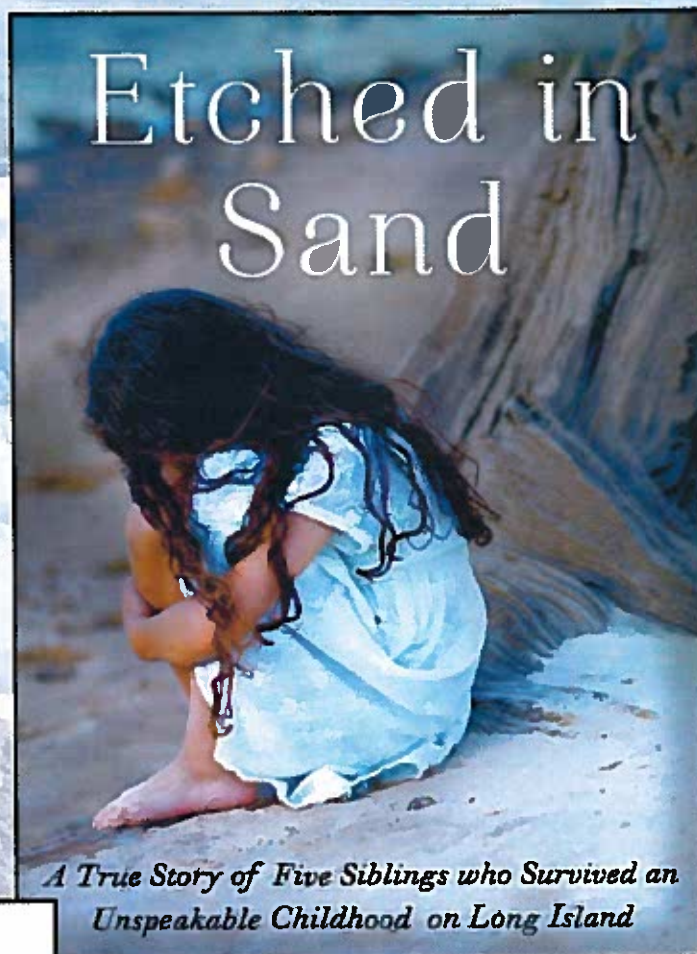
