

# **President Warren Harding**

- <u>"Return to Normalcy"</u> = make U.S. the way it was before WWI.
- Many <u>scandals</u> in his administration

## **Teapot Dome Scandal**

Secretary of the Interior <u>leases gov't land to oil man</u>.

Takes a bribe \_\_\_\_\_\_ went to prison

Restored people's trust in the government.

#### **The RED SCARE**



- Americans feared that <u>COMMUNISM would take over</u>.
- > <u>Strikes and bombings</u> by <u>anarchists</u>(hated the government).

#### Sacco & Vanzetti

- Litalian immigrants accused of robbery and murder.
- > Little evidence against them
- > Found *guilty and executed*





#### **Americans:**

- <u>Feared</u> foreigners
- <u>Lost jobs</u> to foreigners






# **The Stock Market**

- ➤ <u>Installment buying</u> = buying things <u>on credit</u>
