

Containment


The policy of preventing the spread of Communism

- ➤ U.S. flies in supplies for 2 years.

Korean War

- > Tensions arise between North Korea & South Korea
- > Communists invade South Korea in 1950
- <u>U.S. sends military forces</u> to help South Korea




Joseph McCarthy ("McCarthyism")

- > <u>Senator</u> from Wisconsin
- ➤ <u>Accused people</u> in the U.S. government <u>of being Communists</u>
- ➤ <u>He had little evidence</u> to prove his claims

Cuban Missile Crisis (1962)

- > Soviet Union builds missile sites in Cuba
- ➤ They are a <u>DIRECT THREAT to the U.S.</u>
- President Kennedy orders a <u>BLOCKADE around Cuba</u>
- Soviet ships carrying missiles turn back.
